**Russell Henry Chittenden** (18 February 1856 – 26 December 1943) was an American <u>physiological chemist</u>. He conducted pioneering research in the biochemistry of digestion and nutrition.


# Early life and education

He was born in <u>New Haven</u>, <u>Connecticut</u> in 1856, graduated from the <u>Sheffield Scientific School</u> at <u>Yale</u> in 1875, studied in <u>Heidelberg</u> in 1878-79, and received his doctorate at <u>Yale</u> in physiological chemistry in 1880. He was of <u>English</u> ancestry, his first ancestor in America being Major William Chittenden, an officer in the English army, who, having resigned, came to America from Cranbrook, Kent, with his wife, Joanne Sheaffe, in 1639, and settled in Guilford Connecticut. Ancestors of the professor on both his father's and his mother's side fought in the Revolutionary War. <sup>[1]</sup>

### Career

He was professor of physiological chemistry at <u>Yale</u> from 1882 to 1922. He was director of the Sheffield Scientific School from 1898-1922. He was also professor of physiology at the <u>Yale School of Medicine</u> starting in 1900. From 1898 to 1903 he was also a lecturer on physiological chemistry at Columbia University, New York. founding member of the <u>American Physiological Society</u> in 1887 and served as its president from 1895 to 1904.<sup>[2]</sup> He was a member of the Connecticut Academy of Arts and Sciences.

He was the author of *Digestive Proteolysis* and *Physiological Economy in Nutrition* (New York, 1905). During <u>World War I</u>, Professor Chittenden was a member of the Advisory Committee on Food Utilization and also a member of the Executive Committee of the <u>National Research</u> <u>Council</u>. He is often called the "father of American <u>biochemistry</u>." <u>His home</u> in New Haven is a

#### National Historic Landmark.

Chittenden advocated a low-protein diet.<sup>[3]</sup>
