


László Ronkay is the Curator of the Lepidoptera Collection of the Hungarian Natural History Museum since 1995 and working with the taxonomy and distribution of the Noctuoidea for forty years. His results are summarised in almost 200 scientific papers including 8 books in the Noctuidae Europaeae and the Insects of Korea series.



Thomas J. WITT started more than 40 years ago to collect and work with Bombyces (sensu Seitz). He published more than 100 scientific papers on Lepidoptera. He is author of 3 volumes of Bombyces und Sphinges der Westpalaearktis and editor of Lepidoptera of Israel as well as member of the editorial board of Entomofauna-Zeitschrift für Entomologie (founded in 1980). In order to keep his comprehensive collection at disposal for scientific research for future generations he founded the Thomas WITT foundation as associated section of the Zoologische Staatssammlung, Munich.
