**10. mednarodni nevropteroški simpozij /  
10<sup>th</sup> International Symposium on Neuropterology**

Deseti mednarodni nevropteroški simpozij je potekal v Piranu od 22. do 25. junija 2008. Organizatorji srečanja so bili Oddelek za biologijo Fakultete za naravoslovje in matematiko Univerze v Mariboru, Morska biološka postaja Piran ter Slovensko entomološko društvo »Štefana Micheli«. Odločitev za izvedbo simpozija v Sloveniji je bila sprejeta na Devetem mednarodnem nevropteroškem simpoziju, ki je bil junija 2005 v Ferrari v Italiji.

Na simpoziju je sodelovalo 55 udeležencev iz 20 držav iz Evrope, Severne Amerike, Južne Amerike, Azije in Afrike (od tega 40 udeležencev iz Evrope, 5 iz ZDA, 3 iz Brazilije, 2 iz Mehike ter po 1 udeleženec iz Venezuela, Južnoafriške Republike, Irana, Rusije in Japonske). Med udeleženci so bili najbolj ugledni strokovnjaki, ki proučujejo mrežekrilce (Neuropterida: Megaloptera, Raphidioptera, Neuroptera). Prispevki so bili predstavljeni kot predavanja in posterji.

Na srečanju sta bili predstavljeni dve plenarni predavanji in 35 referatov. Slednji so bili razvrščeni v 9 vsebinskih sekcij: Digitalne predstavitev nevropteridov, Taksonomija in sistematika, Biologija in ekologija, Zgodovina nevropterologije, Chrysopidae, Biologija celice, Biologija volkcev, Filogenija in sistematika, Biogeografija. V posterski sekciji je bilo predstavljenih 22 prispevkov. V knjigi izvlečkov, ki obsega 42 strani, je na 30 straneh objavljenih 61 izvlečkov.

Prvi trije dnevi strokovnega srečanja so bili namenjeni predavanjem in predstavljivam posterjev, od 26. do 29. junija pa so bile organizirane štiri ekskurzije po Primorski (Škocjanske jame, dolina Soče, Kobarid, Tolmin, Nadiža), Gorenjski (Triglavski narodni park, Bled, Vintgar), kjer so udeleženci obiskali zanimive habitate z mrežekrilci. Zadnji dan ekskurzije smo si ogledali Prirodoslovni muzej v Ljubljani.

V zaključku lahko zapišemo, da so bili na simpoziju predstavljeni zelo zanimivi rezultati najnovejših raziskav z različnih področij raziskav mrežekrilcev. Ob koncu srečanja so bili udeleženci mnjenja, da je bil simpozij zelo prijetno srečanje nevropterologov v prijazni atmosferi Pirana.

The 10<sup>th</sup> International Symposium on Neuropterology was held in Piran from 22<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> June 2008. The organizers of the symposium were the Department of Biology of the Faculty of Natural Sciences and Mathematics, University of Maribor, the Marine Biology Station of the National Institute of Biology, Piran, and the Slovenian Entomological Society »Štefan Micheli«, Ljubljana. The decision to organize this symposium was adopted at the 9th International Symposium on Neuropterology, which was held in Ferrara, Italy, in June 2005.

The symposium hosted 55 participants from 20 countries from Europe, North America, South America, Asia and Africa (40 from Europe, 5 from USA, 3 from Brasil, 2 from Mexico, 1 from Venezuela, 1 from South Africa, 1 from Iran, 1 from Russia and 1 from Japan). The majority of the participants are well-known experts interested in neuropterid insects (Neuropterida: Megaloptera, Raphidioptera, Neuroptera). The contributions were presented as lectures or as posters.

There were two plenary lectures and 35 lectures arranged in 9 sessions: Digital Initiatives in the Neuropterida, Taxonomy and Systematics, Biology and Ecology, History of Neuropterology, Biology of Chrysopidae, Cell Biology; Biology of the Antlion Larvae, Phylogeny and Systematics, Biogeography. In the poster session 22 contributions were presented. The accompanying 42-page Abstract book comprises 61 abstracts.

The first three days of the symposium were devoted to lectures and poster presentations, and in the period from 26<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> June the participants took part in four excursions which were organized to interesting collecting places in the Primorska region (Škocjanske Jame, the River Soča Valley, Kobarid, Tolmin, Nadiža) and Gorenjska region (Triglav National Park in the Julian Alps, Bled, Vintgar). On the last day of the symposium, the participants visited the Natural History Museum in Ljubljana.

In conclusion, very interesting results of the latest research from different fields of Neuropterology were presented on this symposium. The participants of the meeting were united in the opinion that this symposium was very pleasant meeting of the neuropterologists in a friendly atmosphere of Piran.
