

Some notes on Ecuadorian Saturniidae II

(Lepidoptera, Hemileucinae)

In the present paper the author gives an account of 60 Hemileucinae collected in Ecuador during august 1982, december 1986, may–june 1992, april–may 1993, and october–november 1993. New distributional data of some scarcely known species, such as *Automeris styx*, *Automeris denticulata*, *Leucanella newmanni*, *Pseudoautomeris pohli*, *Hylesia teratex*, *Hylesia indurata*, *Pseudodirphia menander*, improve the Catalogue of ecuadorian Saturniidae (LEMAIRE & VENEDICTOFF, 1989). Some difficulty arises on the classification of the species of the genus *Hylesia*, and about 8 taxa are still under investigation.

The species was originally described by LEMAIRE (1982) from Peru, Tingo Maria, Huanuco, 800 m, and subsequently found in Ecuador, Limon km 22.5, Morona Santiago, about 850 m (LEMAIRE & VENEDICTOFF, 1989). The altitudinal range of the species seems to fit the transitional belt between the eastern rain forest and pre-montane forest.
