

Advances in Amphibian Research in the Former Soviet Union. A new journal

The IUCN / SSC / DAPTF / Regional Group for the Commonwealth of Independent States and the Institute of Ecology and Evolution of the Russian Academy of Sciences launch a new journal, "Advances in Amphibian Research in the Former Soviet Union".

Instructions to authors

"Advances in Amphibian Research in the former Soviet Union" publishes papers on all aspects of amphibian research by authors from the former Soviet Union, as well as papers by foreign authors which concern amphibians within this territory. All topics of batrachology are desired, including systematics, distribution (including new records, maps, and atlases), ecology, behavior, conservation, morphology, evolution, paleontology, physiology, biochemistry, parasitology, genetics, and herpetoculture. Submitted manuscripts may represent original papers, topical reviews, research techniques, recommendations on conservation and sustainable use, and information on meetings, societies, and new books.

Manuscripts should be in English, up to 155K bytes (85 standard type-written pages, including tables and figures), and submitted in the form of both a file and one hard copy. The structure of the manuscript is as follows: name of author(s); their address(es); abstract; introduction; materials and methods; results; discussion; acknowledgments; references; appendix; figure captions. The structure of the main text may vary according to type of contribution.

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R e f e r e n c e s: should be cited in chronological order, e.g., (Thorn, 1968a, b; Golubev and Khozatsky, 1979; Pisachenko et al., 1981), and without initials when noted directly, e.g., Bannikov (1958). Only works mentioned in the text should be included in the References. All bibliographic data should be in the language of the original citation, but in Latin letters. If the Russian or other ex-Soviet original paper contains a parallel English, French, or German title for a book, collection of papers, or article, that title should be given. For journals that are completely translated (e.g., the Russian Journal of Ecology), the citation of the translated version is preferred. Titles of books, journals, and collections of papers (but not individual papers) should be capitalized; the initials of the authors are separated by commas; use "and" before the name of the last author; the publisher is indicated only for books; the language is indicated for papers published in the national languages of the former USSR. Follow these examples:
