Instructions to authors

"Advances in Amphibian Research in the former Soviet Union" publishes papers on all aspects of amphibian research by authors from the former Soviet Union, as well as papers by foreign authors which concern amphibians within this territory. All topics of batrachology are desired, including systematics, distribution (including new records, maps, and atlases), ecology, behavior, conservation, morphology, evolution, paleontology, physiology, biochemistry, parasitology, genetics, and herpetoculture. Submitted manuscripts may represent original papers, topical reviews, research techniques, recommendations on conservation and sustainable use, and information on meetings, societies, and new books.

Manuscripts should be in English, up to 155K bytes (85 standard type-written pages, including tables and figures), and submitted in the form of both a file and one hard copy. The structure of the manuscript is as follows: name of author(s); their address(es); abstract; introduction; materials and methods; results; discussion; acknowledgments; references; appendix; figure captions. The structure of the main text may vary according to type of contribution.
