# **Horace Jayne**

**Horace Fort Jayne** (5 March 1859, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania - 9 July 1913, Wallingford, Pennsylvania)<sup>[1]</sup> was an American zoölogist and educator.

## **Biography**

He was the son of <u>patent medicine</u> millionaire Dr. David Jayne (1799-1866) and Hannah Fort Jayne (1827–1904).<sup>[2]</sup>

He was educated at the <u>University of Pennsylvania</u> (<u>A.B.</u>, 1879; <u>M.D.</u>, 1882), and studied <u>biology</u> at the universities of <u>Leipzig</u> and <u>Jena</u> in 1882–1883, and at <u>Johns Hopkins</u> for a year. In 1884 he was appointed <u>professor</u> of vertebrate morphology at <u>The Wistar Institute of Anatomy and Biology</u>, and became a director of the institute. He was a professor of zoölogy at the University of Pennsylvania from 1894 to 1905, secretary of Penn's biological faculty (1884–1889), and <u>dean</u> of Penn's college faculty (1889–1894). He became a trustee of <u>Drexel Institute</u>, and served as co-editor of several scientific journals.<sup>[3]</sup>

He married ethnologist <u>Caroline Furness Jayne</u> (1873–1909), and they had two children. Their son, <u>Horace H. F. Jayne</u> (1898–1975), became the first curator of Chinese art at the <u>Philadelphia Museum of Art</u>, and later was director of the <u>University of Pennsylvania Museum of Archaeology</u> and Anthropology, and vice director of the Metropolitan Museum of Art.
