**Poetsch.** [Pötsch], **Ignaz Sigismund** (1823-1884), Bohemian-born Austrian botanist and physician; Dr. med. Wien 1849; until 1852 working in various hospitals in Wien; 1852-1854 practicing in Gaming; from 1854-1877 physician (Stifts- und Convictsarzt) at Kremsmünster; from 1875-1884 in retirement at Randegg. (*Poetsch*).

Erlangen 1898; in the judiciary and administration at Ludwigshafen (1904, assistant judge), Kemnath (1916) and Speyer (1919, Regierungsrat; 1932 Regierungsdirektor); from 1934 in semi-retirement at Augsburg; from 1941 retired, from 1945/6 at Karlsruhe and later at Ludwigshafen, specialist on *Uredinales*.
