### 8th Conference of the European Ornithologists' Union 2011 (27-30 August 2011, Riga, Latvia)

The bi-annual conferences provide ideal platforms to get in contact, exchange ideas and disseminate knowledge. This event will be jointly organized by the University of Daugavpils, the University of Latvia and the Latvian Ornithological Society.
