Observations on migrant birds have been made irregularly for at least the past ten years at Cap Gris Nez, for example see Redman (British Birds XLIX 396—7) while Deelder (Ardea 37: 1—88), Perdeck and others have made detailed studies of Chaffinch migrations which embraced the area of Cap Gris Nez.

However, in order to foster regular observations on all aspects of bird migration at the Cap, a committee was recently formed, the members of which are: P. S. Redman (Chairman), P. J. Oliver (Secretary), A. Goulliart, A. Gibbs and J. F. Naylor.

The Committee hopes to encourage observers to visit the Cap so that regular records can be maintained covering nocturnal migrations as well as the diurnal migrations of land and sea birds, and it is our intention to collect together as many records from earlier years as possible.
