Types of papers

The journal publishes original scientific papers, short communications, review articles, book reviews, special issues containing selected and edited papers dealing with a specific theme or based on a conference or workshop. The submission of a paper obliges the author(s) not to submit the same paper elsewhere. Manuscripts are submitted to reviewers for evaluation of their significance and soundness. Authors will generally be notified of acceptance, rejection, or need for revision within three months. The referees remain anonymous. Decisions of the editor are final.
