Investigation area: SW-Pacific - Australia - New Guinea up to and including Sulawesi (to Wallace line). - Material available: All families - extensive material of adults, also large numbers of larvae; great part of Wallace Expedition 1985 to Sulawesi. Material on loan from Leiden and Amsterdam Museum (Sulawesi), large part of New Guinea material from Bishop Museum Honolulu. - Current and future research: Adult taxonomy - Hydropsychidae of Sulawesi, some Philorheitridae of Australia; new Polycentropodidae from Australia, New Guinea and Sulawesi; small collection from Bougainville Isl.; also study of Ulmer's types of Hydropsyche and Hydromanicus spp. from Sulawesi. - Research already done: 1988/91 period publications include Rhyacophilidae, Glossosomatidae, Hydrobiosidae, Polycentropodidae, Psychomyidae, Goeridae, Lepidostomatidae and some Leptoceridae from parts of the investigation area as specified above. - Willing to study adults: yes - Australia - New Guinea - Sulawesi by previous arrangement. - Material wanted: Adults from the entire investigation area. - Comments: Certain groups (genera or families) are under investigation, distributed to a number of investigators.
