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Caddisflies on stamps

Poland has recently issued a stamp with a caddisfly (above). This is probably the first stamp in existence with a recognizable presentation of a Trichoptera species. There was a stamp from the United Nations (New York) with a fantastic caddisfly which was not intended to represent any particular species (below).

The Polish stamp shows a limnephilid which may easily be identified as *Potamophylax luctuosus*; the larva beneath is some other limnephilid. Unfortunately, but not unusually in stamps with insects, the name is wrongly given as „*Limnophilus*“.



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
