Thallus substrato arcte adnatus, plaguliformis, peripheriam versus radiatim effiguratus; gonidia chroolepoidea (in disculum phyllactideum connata). — Erga *Dermatocarpeas*, *Endopyrenieas* et *Pyrenuleas* *Striguleae* se habent ut *Placodieae* erga *Umbilicarieas*, *Parmelieas* et *Lecanoreas*. Species notae omnes sunt foliicolae, sed raro simul et in ramulis junioribus observantur.

Plantae hujus tribus a cl. TREVISAN (Conspect. Verrucar. p. 17) in 4 genera, Haploblastiam, Strigulam, Phyllocharitem et Trichariam disponuntur, sed hoc ultimum genus nil est nisi evolutio peculiaris hypothallina, omni fructificatione carens, quodammodo Isidiis analoga et e generibus delenda. Haploblastia Trev. autem e falso charactere Montagneano Strigulae nitidulae stabilita similiter genus absolute falsum et suppressendum est. Strigulae Trev. dein et Phyllocharis ejusdem, non nisi numero loculorum sporarum diversae, necessario in unum genus Strigulam confluent, sporae enim fere omnium specierum e biloculari demum in formam 4-locularem abeunt.
