LINTON, E. F., John Clavell Mansel-Pleydell, F. G. S., F. L. S. (with Portrait). (Journal of Botany. Vol. XL. 1902. p. 260—263.)

The subject of this biographical notice was born Dec. 4. 1817 and died May 2. 1902. He was a naturalist of wide interests and contributed numerous additions to the knowledge of the Botany, Geology and Zoology of Dorset. This interest in Botany was fostered by correspondence with Sir William Hooker, H. C. Watson, H. Trimmen and other British naturalists and by an acquaintance with French Botanists including the late M. Planchon. His botanical publications included the „Flora of Dorset“ (1874) a second edition of which appeared in 1895 and several contributions to the „Journal of Botany“ and more especially to the „Transactions of the Dorset Natural History and Antiquarian Field Club“. His extensive British and European Herbaria are bequeathed to the County-Museum at Dorchester.
