Three new records of assassin bugs (Hemiptera: Reduviidae: Peiratinae) from Iran

Abstract

Three peiratine species of assassin bugs, *Androclus pictus* (HERRICH-SCHAEFFER), *Ectomocoris ochropterus* STÅL, and *Ectomocoris quadrimaculatus* (SERVILLE), are newly recorded from Iran. Synonymies and distributional data are given in this paper.

K e y w o r d s : Hemiptera, Reduviidae, Peiratinae, Iran, fauna, new record.

Zusammenfassung

Drei für die Fauna Irans neue Raubwanzen [Hemiptera: Reduviidae: Peiratinae: *Androclus pictus* (HERRICH-SCHAEFFER), *Ectomocoris ochropterus* STÅL und *Ectomocoris quadrimaculatus* (SERVILLE)] konnten nachgewiesen werden. Synonymie und Verbreitungsangaben werden angeführt.

Introduction

The family Reduviidae is the largest family of predaceous land Heteroptera, globally comprising of 6.250 species and subspecies in 913 genera and 25 subfamilies (MALDONADO-CAPRILES 1990). Among them 342 species under 31 genera belong to the subfamily Peiratinae. The subfamily Peiratinae distinguishes itself with unique ecological, morphological and behavioural attributes and exhibits affinities with its closer subfamily like Reduviinae and distances itself from subfamilies like Stenopodainae. A thorough understanding of the biosystematics of subfamilies of Reduviidae will reveal their polygenetic relationships (AMBROSE et al. 2007). The assassin bugs of the subfamily Peiratinae were poorly studied in Iran, and only 2 species in 2 genera (*Peirates hybridus* (SCOPOLI 1763)) (MODARRES AWAL 1997) and *Ectomocoris cordiger* STÅL 1866 (AMBROSE et al. 2007) under the subfamily Peiratinae have been recorded. In the present study, we found three new records of Iranian Peiratinae bugs herein reported. The detailed citation and references of the related species can be found in the catalogs of MALDONADO-CAPRILES (1990) and PUTSHKOV & PUTSHKOV (1996).

In this paper, the materials were collected by sweeping net from three localities including, Kaleibar (East Azarbayjan province), Zahedan (Sistan & Baluchestan province) and Kermanshah (Kermanshah province). Totally, three peiratine species of assassin bugs are listed as the new records for Iranian fauna. Additionally, synonymies and distributional data are given below.
