

IV. Addendum to a list of the World genera and species of the family Tenuipalpidae (Acari)

HOSSEIN SEPASGOSARIAN

Sepasgosarian (1983) published a list of the world genera and species of the family Tenuipalpidae with 21 genera and 541 species. He published (1984, 1985 and 1987) 3 addendum lists of the main list. The number of genera and species thus increased to 24 respectively 604. In the meantime 11 authors described 95 new species.

Al-Gboory (1987) and Baker & Tuttle (1987) largely contributed to it. Al-Gboory described 10 new species from different plants in Iraq. Baker & Tuttle described 64 new species from Mexico and recognized 2 new names, 2 synonyms and 2 new combinations. Mohanasundaram (1988) described a new genus and 3 new species. Now the tenuipalpid family comprises 697 species belonging to 25 genera.

A complete catalogue and all papers on tenuipalpid mites are available at the Zool. Inst. Zool. Museum, University of Hamburg, to give assistance to all investigators, if necessary.
