

## Records of African Cassidinae (Col., Chrysomelidae) from the Museum G. Frey

The records included in this report are the results of an expedition to several regions in Africa and therefore the species are listed systematically under geographical headings.

With one exception the specimens were collected by Dr. E. Haaf.

### SOUTH and EAST AFRICA

#### *Aspidomorpha confinis* ssp. *concinna* Weise

*Aspidomorpha concinna* Weise, 1899, Arch. Naturgesch. 65 : 258 (Dar-es-Salaam).

Natal: Pietermaritzburg, XII. 1959, 1 specimen.

This is the South and East African subspecies of *A. confinis* (Klug).

#### *Aspidomorpha debilis* Spaeth

*Aspidomorpha debilis* Spaeth, 1934, Rev. Zool. Bot. Afr. 24 : 385 (Natal).

Natal: Pietermaritzburg, XII. 1959, 4 specimens.

#### *Aspidomorpha lateralis* Weise

*Aspidomorpha lateralis* Weise, 1899, Arch. Naturgesch. 65 (1) : 260 (Morogoro).

Tanganyika: Magamba, Usambara, XI. 1959, 3 specimens.

#### *Aspidomorpha tecta* Boheman

*Aspidomorpha tecta* Boheman, 1854, Mon. Cassid. 2 : 276 (Cape of Good Hope and Caffraria).

Natal: Pietermaritzburg, XII. 1959, 1 specimen.

Two specimens from Pietermaritzburg agree with the ab. *silacea* Boheman. This is a South and East African species.

#### *Aspidomorpha (Weisocassis) prasina* Weise

*Aspidomorpha prasina* Weise, 1899 Arch. Naturgesch. 65 (1) : 258 (Mombo, Kwai: Dar-es-Salaam).

Tanganyika: Makoa, 1400 m., Kilimandjaro, I. 1960, 1 specimen.

*Aspidomorpha (Conchyloctenia) tigrina* (Olivier)

*Cassida tigrina* Olivier, 1808, Ent., 6: 957; 95, t.5, f.78.

Natal: Mahlaleen River, Richmond, XII. 1959, 1 specimen.

Transvaal: Skukuza, Kruger National Park, XI. 1959, 2 specimens; Pretoria, XI. 1959, 1 specimen.

Tanganyika: Dar-es-Salaam, 1959, 1 specimen.

A common South and East African species.

*Ischiocassis convexa* (Boheman)

*Cassida convexa* Boheman, 1854, Mon. Cassid. 2 : 418 (Caffraria).

Transvaal: Skukuza, Kruger National Park, XII. 1959, 2 specimens;

Pretoria, XI. 1959, 2 specimens; Rustenburg, XI. 1959, 1 specimens.

Natal: Mahlaleen River, Richmond, XII. 1959, 5 specimens.

This common South African species is represented by a series showing a wide variation in colour and size.

*Cassida amorifica* Boheman

*Cassida amorifica* Boheman, 1862, Mon. Cassid. 4: 315 (Near Lake N'Gami).

Transvaal: Rustenburg, XI. 1959, 1 specimen.

This species has been recorded from South and East Africa.

*Cassida depicta* Boheman

*Cassida depicta* Boheman, 1862, Mon. Cassid. 4: 315 (Old Calabar).

Uganda: Entebbe, I. 1960, 1 specimen.

A tropical African species recorded from the West coast to the East coast.

*Cassida innotata* Boheman

*Cassida innotata* Boheman, 1854, Mon. Cassid. 2: 403 (Caffraria).

Natal: Pietermaritzburg, XII. 1959, 1 specimen.

A species known from South, Central and tropical Africa.

*Cassida quatuordecim-signata* Spaeth

*Cassida quatuordecim-signata* Spaeth, 1899, Verh. Zool.-bot. Ges. Wien. 49: 217 (Natal).

Natal: Pietermaritzburg, XII. 1959, 3 specimens.

*Cassida thomsoni* Boheman

*Cassida thomsoni* Boheman, 1862, Mon. Cassid. 4: 302 (Near Lake N'Gami).

Transvaal: Skukuza, Kruger National Park, XI. 1959, 2 specimens.

*Cassida vespertilio* Boheman

*Cassida vespertilio* Boheman, 1862, Mon. Cassid. 4: 310 (Cape of Good Hope).

Natal: Pietermaritzburg, XII. 1959, 2 specimens.

*Cassida (Odontionycha) melanophthalma* Boheman

*Cassida melanophthalma* Boheman, 1854, Mon. Cassid. 2: 480 (Cape of Good Hope).

Natal: Mahlaleen River, Richmond, XII. 1959, 1 specimen.

This species has previously been recorded only from Cape Province.

*Aethiopocassis pauli* (Weise)

*Cassida pauli* Weise, 1898, Arch. Naturgesch. 44 (1): 222 (Usambara).

Tanganyika: Magamba, Usambara, XI. 1959, 5 specimens.

*Aethiopocassis plagipennis* (Spaeth)

*Cassida plagipennis* Spaeth, 1916, Ann. naturh. Hofmus. Wien, 30: 46 (Jandala).

Tanganyika: Magamba, Usambara, XI. 1959, 4 specimens.

## C O N G O

*Aspidomorpha areata* (Klug)

*Cassida areata* Klug, 1835, Erman's Reise, Ins.: 48.

Kivu; Bukavu, XI. 1959, 1 specimen.

This specimen is the nominotypical form which has a distribution throughout the eastern half of Africa from Cape Province to Ethiopia.

*Aspidomorpha chlorina* Boheman

*Aspidomorpha chlorina* Boheman, 1854, Mon. Cassid., 2: 259 ("Africa meridionalis?") Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 36 specimens.

Yangambi, XI. 1959, 8 specimens.

A West and Central African species.

*Aspidomorpha confinis* (Klug)

*Cassida confinis* Klug, 1835, Erman's Reise, Ins., 47.

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 14 specimens.

The nominotypical form of this species is found in West and Central Africa.

*Aspidomorpha fatua* Spaeth

*Aspidomorpha (Spaethia) fatua* Spaeth, 1917, Ann. hist. nat. Mus. hung., 15: 429 (Cameroon: Joko).

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 6 specimens.

This little recorded species was previously known only from the Cameroons and the Lulua district of the Congo. The present record indicates that this species is distributed throughout the whole of tropical Central Africa.

*Aspidomorpha icterica* Boheman*Aspidomorpha icterica* Boheman, 1854, Mon. Cassid., 2: 306 (Caffraria).

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 17 specimens.

Yangambi, XI. 1959, 1 specimen.

A well known species from South, Central and West Africa.

*Aspidomorpha isparetta* Boheman*Aspidomorpha isparetta* Boheman, 1854, Mon. Cassid. 2: 252 (Senegal).

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 35 specimens.

Yangambi, XI. 1959, 2 specimens.

This well known tropical African species is very variable in size, shape and colour. The present series includes the ab. *schonherri* Boh., ab. *afzelii* Boh., ab. *stolata* Boh. and the ab. *galamensis* Boh. One particular variant is entirely pale yellow on its dorsal surface and closely resembles *A. diaphana* (Sahlb.) in colour.

*Aspidomorpha mutata* Boheman*Aspidomorpha mutata* Boheman, 1854, Mon. Cassid., 2: 311 (Sierra Leone).

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 5 specimens.

A West and Central African species.

*Aspidomorpha nigromaculata* (Herbst)*Cassida nigromaculata* Herbst, 1799, Natursyst. Käfer, 8: 277; t.133, f.8 (Sierra Leone).

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 11 specimens.

This species is known from West and Central Africa, and from Ethiopia.

*Aspidomorpha obovata* (Klug)*Cassida obovata* Klug, 1835, Erman's Reise, Ins.: 48 (Isle de Prince).

Yangambi, XI. 1959, 2 specimens.

Recorded from the West and Central area of tropical Africa.

*Aspidomorpha officiosa* Boheman*Aspidomorpha officiosa* Boheman, 1862, Mon. Cassid. 4: 255 (Old Calabar).

Yangambi, XI. 1959, 2 specimens.

This species is known from West Africa and the Congo.

*Aspidomorpha quadrimaculata* (Olivier)*Cassida quadrimaculata* Olivier, 1808, Ent., 6: 945: 97, t.4, f.68.

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 1 specimen.

A West, Central and East African species.

*Aspidomorpha quadriramosa* Boheman

*Aspidomorpha quadriramosa* Boheman, 1854, Mon. Cassid., 2: 305 (Guinea).

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 2 specimens.

Yangambi, XI. 1959, 3 specimens.

A West and Central African species.

*Aspidomorpha strigosa* (Gorham)

*Cassida strigosa* Gorham, 1892, Proc. Zool. Soc. Lond., 95 (Aruwimi Valley).

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 5 specimens.

Yangambi, XI. 1959, 2 specimens.

An East and Central African species.

*Aspidomorpha togata* Thomson

*Aspidomorpha togata* Thomson, 1858, Arch. Ent., 2: 227 (Old Calabar).

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 2 specimens.

Yangambi, XI. 1959, 1 specimen.

This species is known from West and Central Africa and is represented in this collection by two specimens of *A. togata ruwensorica* ab. *pinguis* Spaeth and one specimen (Yangambi) of *A. togata* ab. *segregata* Spaeth.

*Aspidomorpha (Conchyloctenia) mouffleti* (Boheman)

*Cassida mouffleti* Boheman, 1854, Mon. Cassid., 2: 346 (Gabon).

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 1 specimen.

A West, Central and East African species.

*Laccoptera (Eulaccoptera) corrugata* (Sahlberg)

*Cassida corrugata* Sahlberg, 1823, Peric. Ent. 4: 60, t.3, f.6.

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 28 specimens.

Yangambi, XI. 1959, 8 specimens.

A common West and Central African species.

*Cassida tosta* Klug

*Cassida tosta* Klug, 1835, Erman's Reise, Ins., 47.

Yangambi, XI. 1959, 3 specimens.

Two of these specimens are uniformly brown in colour. A West, Central and East African species.

*Chiridopsis aubei* (Boheman)

*Coptocyclus aubei* Boheman, 1855, Mon. Cassid. 3: 195 (Old Calabar).

Ituri; Nia-Nia, XI. 1959, 48 specimens.

Yangambi, XI. 1959, 11 specimens.

This species has been recorded from West Africa to Uganda and Tanganyika.

*Chiridopsis baumani* (Spaeth)

*Chirida baumani* Spaeth, 1902, Ann. Soc. ent. Belg., 46: 459 (Mgala; Kagera-Nil, prope lacum Ukerewe).

Kivu; Bukavu, XI. 1959, 3 specimens.

A West, Central and East African species.
