## Instructions for authors:

Manuscripts can be submitted in German or English; in any case, an English abstract has to be included. Manuscripts should be typed on one side of a DNA-4 sheet, double-spaced and with broad margins. Scientific names of plants of all ranks should be underlined (wavy line) or typed in italics, authors of cited literature underlined (straight line) or in SMALL CAPITALS, chapter titles underlined (double line) or typed in bold letters. The text should be submitted additionally as an electronic text file on a 3½' disk or transmitted by e-mail, preferably in Word-compatible programs (in this case, italics, SMALL CAPITALS, and bold letters can be done in the file).

The manuscript (short reports excepted) should start with title, name of all authors, and Abstract; introduction, material and methods, results (where are the voucher specimens housed?), discussion, and references should be included and organized within chapters in a meaningful manner. Contributions in a recent number should be consulted as examples.

References should be cited in the text in the following manner: according to MILLER (1996), MILLER & al. (1997)" or "several records have been published (MILLER 1996, MILLER & al. 1997)". In the chapter "References", only literature cited in the text is to be included and should be given in the following manner:

BALL P. W., 1968: Seseli. – In: TUTIN T. G. & al. (Eds.): Flora Europaea 2: 334–338. – Cambridge (U. K.): Cambridge University Press.

<u>Abbreviations</u>: For citations of public herbaria the abbreviations of Index Herbariorum (HOLMGREN & al. 1990, Regn. Veget. 120) have to be used; abbreviations of private herbaria should be explained separately. Abbreviations of journals should follow B-P-H (Botanico-Periodicum Huntianum). Other abbrevations must be explained within the text.

<u>Tables</u> can be included in the text or should be submitted as graphs and drawings, in a state ready for printing. <u>Illustrations</u> should be designed as to be readable after reduction to the size of type area of the journal; the space needed for the caption has to be taken into consideration. <u>Linear bar scales</u> should be included into illustrations to indicate magnification. <u>Graphics</u> should be worked out in Indian ink or printed by a laser printer. <u>Photographs</u> should be glossy, showing good contrast and sharp lines. Subunits of figures should be numbered by numbers or letters ready for press. Each illustration should be numbered by pencil, the corresponding captions should be given on a separate sheet and provided possibly also as a text file.
