Thallus crassus, tartareus, albidus vel lutescens, passim pulvinatus, determinatus, superficie tenuiter granuloso-rugulosa; apothecia (lirellae) numerosa, gracilenta, valde flexuosa et intricata, immersa, crustam paene totam obtegentia, thallo concoloria, intus pallida, marginibus augustis, epithecio tenuiter rimiformi; spora 6nae, primo incolores, dein pallide olivaceae, oblongae vel ovoido-oblongae, 6-loculares, loculis crebro binucleolatis, long. 0,028—0,033, crass. 0,009—0,012 mm.

Corticola (coll. 3374).

Thallus hydrate kalico ex aurantiaco intense sanguinescit.

Species quoad apotheciorum formam situmque similis *Graphidi Poitaei* Fée, caeterum ad stirpem *Fissurinarum* pertinens.

Stipes rigidus, fibrose farctus, extus eximie cartilagineus, 1—3" longus, 3—4" crassus, e basi ventricosa fusiformi caudatus—vel totus fusiformis, pulverulentus, fulvo-ferrugineus. Pileus carnosus, e convexo planus, obtusus, pro ratione parvus, pollicaris, laevis, glaber, rufus. Lamellae emarginato-subliberae et secedentes, firmae, distantes, pileo pallidiores. Caro flava. — *Ag. fusipedi* affinis, sed ab hoc abunde diversus. — In sylvis ad pedem montis „Boschberg“ prope Somerset-East, Promont: bonae spei. 1875. Leg. P. Mac Owan. (no. 1013.)

34. *Agaricus (Clitocybe) gentianeus* Quel. Champ. du Jura et des Vosges II. pag. 320. Tb. I. fg. 5. — Statione *Clitocybis* inconsueta et stipite basi incrassato differt a fungo Queletii, sapor quoque ignotus; sed omnino est e foedere *Ag. amari* Fr., *Ag.*

*vulpeculae* Kalchbr. et *Ag. amarella* Pers. — In vetusto stercore bovino in monte „Boschberg“ prope Somerset-East, Promont: bonae spei. 1875. Leg. P. Mac Owan. (no. 1013 b.)

35. *Agaricus (Crepidotus) proteus* Kalchbr. nov. spec.

Cetero congruunt et evolutionis modus in utroque idem. — In ligno humido, fabrefacto, clathrato, vitifero, hortensi prope Somerset-East, Promont: bonae spei. Januario 1876. Leg. P. Mac Owan. (no. 1202.)

36. *Coprinus curtus* Kalchbr. nov. spec. — Thümen, Mycotheea universalis no. 403. —

Fragilis, gregarius, e vicinia *Coprini plicatilis* sed multo humilior. — Stipes fistulosus, strictus, laevis, glaber, 2—7" longus, vix 1" crassus, pallidus, sed deorsum subincrassatus, ibidemque albo-pulverulentus. Pileus e cylindrico ovato campanulatus, 3—4" altus, ferrugineo-furfurellus, demum cinereus, sulcatus. Lamellae nigro-griseae, acie albicantes. Sporae creberrimae, majusculae, ovatae, nigrae — In stercore vaccino inter frutices ad pedem montis „Boschberg“ prope Somerset-East, Promont: bonae spei. Jan. 1875. Leg. P. Mac Owan. (no. 1014.)

37. *Stereum amoenum* Kalchbr. nov. spec.

Sessile, membranaceum. Pileis postice coarctatis, confluentibus, planiusculis, villosis, zonatis, canescentibus, hymenio laevi, glabro, albido-lilacino. — In truncis vetustis sylvarum montis „Boschberg“ prope Somerset-East, Promont: bonae spei. 1875. Leg. P. Mac Owan. (no. 1086.)

38. *Broomeia congregata* Berk. in London Jour. of Botany 1844. III. p. 193. Tb. VI. A.

In ligno vetusto putrido pr. Somerset-East, Promont: bonae spei. 1875. Raro. Leg. P. Mac Owan. — Fungus insignis, caryophylli odore! —

**Ae.** acervulis hypophyllis, raro amphigenis, congestis, concentrico dispositis, prominentibus, rotundis, flavo-albescensibus, demum umbrinis, ore sublacerato; sporis globosis, diaphanis, episporio laevi, 24—28 mm. in diam., decoloribus. — Ad *Oxilidis Bowei* Lodd. (*O. purpuratae* Jacq. var.) folia viva in dumetis montis „Boschberg“ prope Somerset-East, Promont: bonae spei. Jan. 1876. Leg. P. Mac Owan. (no. 1142.)

**42. *Puccinia Cephalandrae* Thm. nov. spec.**

**P.** acervulis hypophyllis, sparsis, applanatis, orbiculatis, umbrinis, liberis; sporis ovatis vel ellipsoideis, medio obsolete constrictis, vertice non incrassato sed apiculato, apiculo pallide fuscamente, 8 mm. longo, episporio tenui, laevi, in constrictiibus crassiore, granuloso, pedicellatis, pedicello tenui, curvato vel recto, hyalino, longitudinis sporarum vel longiore, usque ad 52 mm., impellucidis, fuscis, 42—45 mm. long. (sine apice pedicelloque), 26 mm. crass., paraphysibus nullis. — In fruticetis ad latera montis „Boschberg“ prope Somerset-East, Promont: bonae spei ad *Cephalandrae quinquelobae* Schrad. folia viva. Leg. P. Mac Owan. (no. 1146.)

**43. *Puccinia exhaustiens* Thm. nov. spec.**

**P.** acervulis hypophyllis, minutis, rotundatis, planis, sparsis dein confluentibus, in macula non limitata expallida, straminea, brunneis; sporis valde variis: clavatis, ellipsoideo-clavatis aut fere ovatis, medio constrictis, episporio tenui, laevi, vertice subincrassato, loculo inferiore subattenuato, loculo superiore oblongo-ovatis, 40—50 mm. long., 20—22 mm. crass., dilute griseis, subdiaphanis, pedicello brevissimo, hyalino. — *Puccinia Jasmini* De C. in Jasmino fruticante folia fere tota occupans, sporis ovatis, episporio crassissimo, pedicello longo, brunneis, toto coelo diversa est. In *Jasmini tortuosi* Willd. foliis vivis inter dumeta montis „Boschberg“ prope Somerset-East, Promont: bonae spei. 1875. Leg. Tuck et P. Mac Owan. (no. 1139.)
