DISTRIBUTIONAL ASPECTS OF ROTIFERA IN CENTRAL AND SOUTH CHILE

Abstract

115 Taxa of rotifers are recorded for 29 Chilean lakes, among them 12 species are first time records in the country. 5% of the taxa show a wide distribution between Central and South zones, while 14% exhibit random occurrence. The majority of the species (81%) are restricted to either Central or Southern regions. As a consequence, low taxonomic associations between lakes were observed, and it would imply that each lake has a relatively specific rotifer fauna.
