A catalogue of the Chrysididae (Hymenoptera, Chryridoidea) of Gabon

A b s t r a c t: The family Chrysididae is represented by 14 species of the subfamily Chrysidinae. The genus *Chrysis* LINNAEUS, 1761 is known by seven species and *Hedychrum* LATREILLE, 1802 by two species. The genera *Holophris* MOCSARY, 1890, *Praestochrysis* LINSENMAIER, 1959, *Primeuchroeus* LINSENMAIER, 1968, *Stilbum* SPINOLA, 1806 and *Trichrysis* LINSENMAIER, 1968 are each represented by one species.

Introduction

MADL & ROSA (2012) recorded 13 species of the family Chrysididae from Gabon. The species belong to the tribes Chrysidini (genera *Chrysis* LINNAEUS, 1761, *Praestochrysis* LINSENMAIER, 1959, *Primeuchroeus* LINSENMAIER, 1968, *Trichrysis* LINSENMAIER, 1968) and Elampini (genera *Hedychrum* LATREILLE, 1802, *Holophris* MOCSÁRY, 1890).

The Chrysidid fauna of Gabon is poorly explored concerning species composition and distribution. The biology is unknown.

Annotated catalogue

Synonyms are marked with an asterisk (*). In "distribution" only localities situated in Gabon are mentioned. The general distribution data are based on an updated and unpublished version of MADL & ROSA (2012).

Subfamily Chrysidinae

Chrysis aureomaculata is also recorded from the Central African Republic (should be confirmed), Democratic Republic of the Congo (should be confirmed), "French Congo", "Guinea" and Uganda. The record from Gabon is not mentioned in KIMSEY & BOHART (1991: 386).

Chrysis laborans, which is widely distributed in the Afrotropical Region, is also recorded from Equatorial Guinea (Mbini, Bioko) and Cameroon.

Chrysis lincea, which is known from the Afrotropical (widespread), Australian, Oriental and Palaearctic regions, is also recorded from Equatorial Guinea (Mbini, Annobon), Cameroon, Republic of the Congo and Sao Thomé & Principe (both islands).

Primeuchroeus ghilianii is also recorded from Cameroon, Nigeria (?), South Africa, Uganda (?) and Zimbabwe. The record from Gabon is not mentioned in BISCHOFF (1913: 43).

***Stilbum cyanurum* (FORSTER, 1771)**

Stilbum cyanurum, which is known from the Afrotropical (widespread), Palaearctic, Oriental and Australian regions, is also known from Cameroon and the Republic of the Congo. MADL & ROSA (2012: 122) recorded *Stilbum cyanurum* from Gabon (KOHL 1894: 344) but the locality Loango is situated in the Republic of the Congo.

***Trichrysis fraterna* (MOCSÁRY, 1889)**

Trichrysis fraterna, which is widely distributed in the Afrotropical Region, is also recorded from Cameroon and the Republic of the Congo.

***Hedychrum haugianum* DU BUYSSEN, 1903**

Hedychrum haugianum is recorded only from Gabon.

***Holophris congoensis* DU BUYSSEN, 1900**

Distribution: Estuaire: Gabon without exact locality (MANTERO 1910).

Holophris congoensis is also known from the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Equatorial Guinea (Mbini), Uganda and Zambia. The record from Gabon is not mentioned in KIMSEY & BOHART (1991: 247).

Zusammenfassung

Die Familie Chrysidae ist in Gabon mit 14 Arten der Unterfamilie Chrysinae vertreten. Die Gattung *Chrysis* LINNAEUS, 1761 ist mit sieben Arten vertreten und *Hedychrum* LATREILLE, 1802 mit zwei Arten. Die Gattungen *Holophris* MOCSÁRY, 1890, *Praestochrysis* LINSENMAIER, 1959, *Primeuchroeus* LINSENMAIER, 1968, *Stilbum* SPINOLA, 1806 und *Trichrysis* LINSENMAIER, 1968 sind mit jeweils einer Art nachgewiesen.
