A catalogue of the family Chrysididae (Hymenoptera, Chryridoidea) of Eritrea

A b s t r a c t : In Eritrea the family Chrysididae is represented by 40 known species of the subfamily Chrysidinae. The genus *Chrysis* LINNAEUS, 1761 is known by 26 species. The genera *Hedychridium* ABEILLE DE PERRIN, 1878 and *Hedychrum* LATREILLE, 1802 are each represented by four species and *Euchroeus* LATREILLE, 1809, *Holopyga* DAHLBOM, 1845, *Parnopes* LATREILLE, 1796, *Praestochrysis* LINSENMAIER, 1959, *Pseudospinolia* LINSENMAIER, 1951 and *Stilbum* SPINOLA, 1806 are each known by one species. *Chrysis xanthocera* KLUG, 1845 is deleted from the species list of Eritrea.

Introduction

MADL & ROSA (2012) catalogued the Chrysididae or cuckoo wasps of the Afrotropical Region. They recorded 41 species of the subfamily Chrysidinae from Eritrea representing the tribes Chrysidini (genera *Chrysis* LINNAEUS, 1761, *Euchroeus* LATREILLE, 1809, *Praestochrysis* LINSENMAIER, 1959, *Pseudospinolia* LINSENMAIER, 1951, *Stilbum* SPINOLA, 1806), Elampini (genera *Hedychridium* ABEILLE DE PERRIN, 1878, *Hedychrum* LATREILLE, 1802, *Holopyga* DAHLBOM, 1845) and Parnopini (*Parnopes* LATREILLE, 1796).

Chrysis xanthocera KLUG, 1845 is deleted from the Eritrean species list, because the record from Eritrea (TRAUTMANN 1927: 93 as *Pseudochrysis pallidicornis alfierii* nov.var.: "Diese Rasse ist noch von Tripolis, Erytrea und Biskra in Algerien bekannt") is most probably a printing error. "Erytrea" should be replaced by Libya. The Eritrean record is not mentioned in KIMSEY & BOHART (1991: 380) and LINSENMAIER (1999: 214), but in MADL & ROSA (2012: 80). Currently, no records of *Chrysis xanthocera* are known from Eritrea.

Chrysidinae are known mainly as parasitoids of solitary aculeate wasps (Masarinae, Eumeninae), Crabronidae, Sphecidae) and bees (Apidae, Halictidae, Megachilidae) except the genus *Praestochrysis*, which is a parasitoid of Limacodidae (Lepidoptera). Nothing is known about the biology of the Eritrean species except a host record of *Stilbum cyanurum* (FORSTER, 1771) by KLATT (2013).

Annotated catalogue

Synonyms are marked with an asterisk (*). In "distribution" only localities situated in Eritrea are listed. The general distribution data are based on an updated and unpublished version of MADL & ROSA (2012).

Zusammenfassung

Die Familie Chrysididae ist in Eritrea mit 40 nachgewiesenen Arten aus der Unterfamilie Chrysidiinae vertreten. Die Gattung *Chrysis* LINNAEUS, 1761 ist mit 26 Arten vertreten, und je vier Arten sind von den Gattungen *Hedychridium* ABEILLE DE PERRIN, 1878 und *Hedychrum* LATREILLE, 1802 bekannt. Die Gattungen *Euchroeus* LATREILLE, 1809, *Holopyga* DAHLBOM, 1845, *Parnopes* LATREILLE, 1796, *Praestochrysis* LINSENMAIER, 1959, *Pseudospinolia* LINSENMAIER, 1951 und *Stilbum* SPINOLA, 1806 sind mit je einer Art nachgewiesen. *Chrysis xanthocera* KLUG, 1845 wurde von der Artenliste Eritreas gelöscht.
