


Fig. 1. *Macacus sanguineus*.—Plate 2.




Fig. 2. *C. leucophaea* (Bennett).




Fig. 11. Der weisse Weißkopf oder Blank. (Mico satanas.)




Fig. 14. *Archicebus* or *Callicebus* *leucophaeus* (Linnæus). *Apes*.






Fig. 24. der Servalkatze oder der dünke. *Leptailurus serval*.




Fig. 24. *Acinonyx jubatus* (Linné) - *Cheetah* - *Cheetah* - *Cheetah*.




Fig. 11. Der kleinere oder zitronenfarbene Aborigine




Fig. 24. *Amphis*, *Amphibolites*. *Amphibolites* *Amphis*. — Fig. 25. *Amphis*, *Amphibolites*. *Amphis*, *Amphibolites*. — Fig. 26. *Amphis*, *Amphibolites*. *Amphis*, *Amphibolites*. — Fig. 27. *Amphis*, *Lenticularia*. *Amphis*, *Lenticularia*.








Fig. 122. *the griseofulvous seal* (*Urocyon grisescens*).




Fig. 20. Delphinus delphis, Risso.


