Birds Eggs.

Mr. J. C. Stevens will sell by auction at his rooms 38 King Street, Covent Garden, London early in February 1856 some rare eggs collected in Lapland by an English Gentleman in the past season. Among them are eggs of *Aquila fulva*, — *Falco gyrfalco* — *Strix nisoria* (*Naum.*) — *Lusciola cyaneola orientalis*, *Schl.* — *Anthus rufogularis* — *Parus sibiricus* — *Alauda alpestris* — *Fringilla borealis* — *F. montifringilla* — *Pyrrhula enucleator* — *Garrulus infaustus* — *Totanus fuscus* — *T. glareola* — *T. glottis* — *Tringa temminckii* — *T. platyrhyncha* (*Limicola pygmaea*, *Naum.*) — *Scolopax gallinula* — *Anser minutus*, *Naum.* — *Anas acuta* — *A. penelope* — *A. fuligula* — *A. clangula* — *A. glacialis* — *A. nigra* — *A. fusca* — *Eudytes arcticus* — *E. septentrionalis* etc.

Each egg was carefully marked at the time it was obtained, and has also a reference to the private note-book in which particulars are entered. — Catalogues with details may be had of Mr. Stevens, by whom also enquiries or commissions will receive every attention. —
