Sepala viridia, petalis $\frac{1}{2}$ — $\frac{1}{3}$ breviora, sub anthesi erecto-patula, postea subreflexa. Petala patula, aurea, obovato-orbiculata, brevissime unguiculata. Carpophorum nullum. Carpella imatura minima, 3^{mm} lg., 1^{mm} lt., sicuti rostrum non articulatam 16—20^{mm} longum pilis mollibus brevibus et longissimis tenuissimisque ad apicem usque aequaliter villosa.

Radice repenti, gracili, perenni, caules pluriore emittent. Caulibus hispidulis; fructiferis altitudine pedis circiter, adscendentibus, erectis.

Foliis crenulatis, glabris; inferioribus elliptice lanceolatis, subrotundis, in petiolum attenuatis; superioribus sessilibus, subamplexicaulibus, e basi lata in apicem rotundatam sensim angustatis; supremis in bracteolas anguste ellipticas, integerrimas sensim transiuntibus.

Pedunculis erectis, calice quadruplo longioribus.

Calice quadripartito, lobis ovatis, obtusis, margine hispidulis, magnitudine inaequali.

Corolla albida-lilacina, tubo brevi instructa.

Capsula compressa, planiuscula, transverse latiore, acute emarginata, reniforme-obcordata, glabriuscula, margine ciliata.

Floribus in racemo simplici, laxo, elongate dispositis.

Habitu Veronicae serpyllifoliae maxime est propinqua, sed facile distinguitur pedunculis longioribus, capsulis incisae foliorumque forma.

Crescit in nemore umbroso silvae. „Bulau“ prope „Hanau am Main.“
