In the *Geographical Journal* for 1898 (vol. XI, p. 498-509), will be found an account of Dr. Donaldson Smith's « Journey through the Khin-ghan mountains », with his two friends. Leaving Peking on the 19th of May 1897, the route of the travellers lay to the northward through the Khin-ghan mountains to Dolon-Nor, « a large trading centre between China and Mongolia », and thence in a north-easterly direction to Tsitsihar and Vladivostock.

On their journey the three travellers made natural history collections, and they have very kindly presented the British Museum with a set of the birds, of which I have prepared a list. The synonymy I have added affords a better idea of the species and their distribution in Eastern Asia than any long explanation I might give, as it points out whether the species are already known to be Mongolian or Chinese. Most of them are to be found in the pages of Prjevalski's work and in the account of Berezowski's collections in Gan-su; while the majority of them are also included in David and Oustalet's *Oiseaux de la Chine*

and Taczanowski's *Faune ornithologique de la Sibérie orientale*. The chief interest in the collection made by Dr. Donaldson Smith and the Messrs. Farnum consists in the fact that all the birds were obtained during the summer, and that probably every one was nesting in the localities where it was procured. In this respect the records are certainly of considerable importance.

This specimen seems to be a somewhat pale form of

S. curruca, but after comparison with a series of our European bird, I have come to the conclusion that it cannot be specifically distinguished, though it is somewhat lighter in colour. Abbé David found the Lesser Whitethroat nesting in the mountains of N. E. China, and in the Ou-rato mountains in Mongolia. Among the birds from Gilgit, collected by Colonel Biddulph are two specimens which I refer to the true *S. curruca*, a species not yet recorded within the Indian area.
