Dear Trichopterologist,

The time of our third International Symposium on Trichoptera comes nearer, and many of us will meet again in Perugia. Please find enclosed the definitive circular with the application forms. In October I spent some fine weeks at the Institute of Professor Moretti in Perugia, and I got the impression that the preparations for the symposium proceed very well.

In May and June last year I was again in the South for field studies. I visited the islands of Kerkyra, Crete, Samos, Ikaria, Tinos, Andros, Euboea, and Thasos, and I made large and fine collections. Two light traps were successfully operated over a period of two years in Crete to obtain phenological information on caddisflies and other insects. Our friend Botosaneanu undertook a difficult but successful expedition to Haiti and Jamaica in autumn.

This Newsletter contains, besides some information, the continuation of the literature list and the list of fellow workers. The next issue is expected to appear some time after the Perugia meeting. If you have any information, questions or other items which might be of interest to fellow workers (e.g. reports on collecting trips, on current investigations), please send me manuscripts.
