BIBLIOGRAPHY EXCHANGE

It has been suggested that participants in the Fourth International Symposium on Trichoptera may desire to engage in an exchange of bibliographies of their publications concerning Trichoptera. This exchange will help our research efforts in several important ways:

 To provide a check against omissions from the bibliographies being prepared by L.W.G.HIGLER (for Trichopterorum Catalogus supplements), by A.P.NIMMO (for his topical bibliography), by H.MALICKY (for Trichoptera Newsletter), and by the North American Benthological Society (for annual bibliographies on benthic biology) and other such organizations;

2. To help faster reprint exchanges among trichopterologists internationally; and

3. To help assure accuracy and completeness for literature citations in our future research publications.

Symposium participants and other trichopterologists desiring to take part in the bibliography exchange should send their personal Trichoptera bibliography to me by 31 May 1983. I will then make sufficient photocopies for distribution to all attendees at the Symposium.
