Published privately by the author, this series was the first major attempt to review the Trichoptera fauna of North America north of Mexico. The text in the form of keys to species, organized by family, contains the original species descriptions. Following each family key are brief notes and a checklist of species and synonyms. New taxa established in the series includes 8 genera, 5 subgenera, 57 species, and 4 subspecies. Twelve generic and 235 species synonyms were also presented. Most of the new species were in the Limnephilidae (15) and the Rhyacophilidae (22). This series should be a welcome addition to the files of caddis workers interested in the original descriptions of many North American species.
