

HALIPLIDAE: Additional notes on the Haliplidae of China and neighbouring countries (Coleoptera)

Abstract

Additional faunistic data on the Haliplidae (Coleoptera) of China and neighbouring countries are given. Several species are for the first time reported from countries or Chinese provinces.

Key words: Coleoptera, Haliplidae, China, East Palearctic region, Oriental Region, faunistics.

Introduction

Since the revisions of the Palearctic and Oriental *Liaphlus* GUIGNOT and *Peltodytes* RÉGIMBART species (VONDEL 1991, 1992, 1993) and the review of the Haliplidae of China (VONDEL 1995) additional material became available, which is listed in this paper.
