Es fiel mir auf, daß sich mit Leichtigkeit zwei Schalenformen dieser Schnecke unterscheiden ließen, die eine lang und schlank mit uniformer bläulich-weißer Farbe, die andere kurz und gedrungen mit hell- und dunkelgrauer schachbrettartiger Zeichnung, beide auch durch
