

THIRD REPORT ON THE PROGRESS OF THE “ADUMBRATIO FLORAE AETHIOPICAE”

RODOLFO E. G. PICHI SERMOLLI

The “Adumbratio Florae Aethiopicae” is a series of papers devoted to the taxonomic revision of the Pteridophytes and Spermatophytes of Ethiopia (including Eritrea), Somalia and Socotra.

The publication of the “Adumbratio Florae Aethiopicae” was undertaken in 1953 and eight accounts have been issued since the last A.E.T.F.A.T. Meeting in 1966 (*Acta Phytogeogr. Suec.* 54: 290. 1968). On the whole 26 families have been studied, and the following 21 accounts have been published up to this time:
